0	5	Warning Signal	“R” 		
1	4	Preparatory Signal (Flags “P”, “T”, or Black Flag). It is suggested you use “P” unless you have already had a general recall, in which case it is probably advisable to use the black flag.	“P” 		
4	1	One Minute Signal			
5	0	Start			

	Individual Recall If <u>identifiable</u> individuals are “over the Line” prior to the start	“X” 		
Start plus 4	At start plus 4 minutes or earlier if all boats over the line have returned to the prestart side of the line by rounding the end of the line.			

	General Recall	“1 st Sub” 		
-1	One minute before the next signal (warning for the restart)			

	On Station for Finish			
	<i>If shortening the course</i> As the first boat to be finished rounds the last mark	“S” 		
	As each boat finishes			
	After the last boat finishes
