

Sailing Instruction 29

“The member who is Club Race Officer and the member who is Assistant Race Officer may claim “average points” for the races they run. A member may count a maximum of two average points scores (“OODs”) for each series, providing that the number of “OODs” counted does not exceed 20 % of the races that took place in the series. The exceptions to this are the Holcot Handicap Series where three “OOD” scores may be counted, again providing that the number of “OODs” does not exceed 20 % of the races that took place in the series and any “Sprint” series where a maximum of 10% of the races that took place in the series may be counted. Average points are based on the member’s “non DNC” results. Members will only be awarded OOD points for a single nominated boat in any particular series”

Clarification

OOD points may be claimed by the crew of a boat provided that the helm / crew combination remains the same throughout the series.

e.g. Helm A sails with Crew B in races 1, 3, and 5.

For race 6 Crew B is away and Helm A does OOD duty. OOD points count. (subject to limits in s.i. 29)

For race 7 Helm A is away and Crew B does OOD duty. OOD points count. (subject to limits in s.i. 29)

For race 8 Crew B is away and Helm A sails with Crew C OOD points from race 6 still count but OOD points from race 7 no longer count. (subject to limits in s.i. 29)
